WHAT DOES 501 (C) (3) MEAN?

As you may have noticed on the front page of the Newsletter, we now include that identification; but what does it indicate?

Last year, our President, Hank Johnson filed the documents for The Channel Cities Jazz Club to become a Public Charity under the Internal Revenue Code which makes the Club Tax exempt from Federal Taxation under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Contributions to the Club are now tax deductible just like to The Good Will or Disabled Veterans. The Club is qualified to receive tax deductible bequests, devises, transfers, donations or gifts and the contributor can list it as a tax deduction when they file their taxes.

This also makes it possible for dedicated members to legally mention the Club in their Will or Trust and be assured that Jazz will live on indefinitely.

The charity of our members make it possible to send talented young musicians to Jazz Camp each year, thus laying the foundation to perpetuate our beloved music far beyond our generation.
